

There are many hotels in the city centre and in the Jesmond area of Newcastle. The venue is 4km from the city centre by car.



BY AIR

Newcastle International Airport has direct flights from many European countries including international hubs at Paris and Amsterdam. BY TRAIN

Newcastle is two and a half hours away from London, Manchester, Glasgow and Edinburgh. Newcastle Central station is in walking distance of most of the city centre hotels.

BY SEA

DFDS seaways run a ferry from Amsterdam to the Port of Newcastle 7 times a week. The Ferry port is 10 miles from the venue and connected by Metro to the city centre.

BY ROAD

There are bus services from most major cities to Newcastle. There are over 10,000 car parking spaces in the city centre, but these all have daily charges.

SOCIAL EVENT
