 - Dublin March 2026
 - Málaga November 2026
- ► AETF European Qualifying Umpire Course February 2026 in Maribor
- ► AETF European Championships April 2026 in Maribor
- ► Launch of new committee-led projects, including:
 - the AETF Fair Play Awards, promoting sportsmanship and integrity
 - the AETF Technical Course, supporting the harmonisation and development of technical standards across Europe

These activities will continue to build on the strong foundations we set this year, offering new opportunities for athletes, umpires, coaches, and National Associations across our continent.



I am deeply proud of what we have achieved together during 2025. Our progress is not the work of individuals—it is the result of a **united European Taekwon-Do family** committed to cooperation, transparency, and the future of our sport.
